

WHAT WE BELIEVE

We believe that both the Old and New Testament constitute the divinely inspired Word of God, inerrant in the original texts.

II Timothy 3:16-17; II Peter 1:20-21

We believe in one God, existing eternally in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Genesis 1:1-3, 26; John 1:1-2, 14

We believe that the Holy Spirit came forth from the Father and the Son to convict the world of sin, or righteousness and of judgment; and to regenerate, sanctify, comfort, and bring assurance of salvation to those who believe in Jesus Christ; and to empower them to use spiritual gifts for the carrying out the work of the ministry.

We believe in the baptism, and filling of the Holy Spirit with accompanying signs and wonders as the spirit of God directs with purpose of glorifying God in the earth.

We believe that the carnal nature of man is totally depraved, and entirely unable to remedy his lost condition

We believe that salvation, with its forgiveness of sins, its importation of a new nature, and its hope of eternal life, is entirely apart from good works, baptism, church membership or man's effort, and is of pure grace.

Ephesians 2:8-10

II Corinthians 5:17-18

We believe in the baptism by water of believers, symbolizing the believer's union in the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Matthew 28:18-20

We believe in observance of the Lord's Supper commemoration the sacrifice of our Savior for all mankind.

I Corinthians 11:23-26
